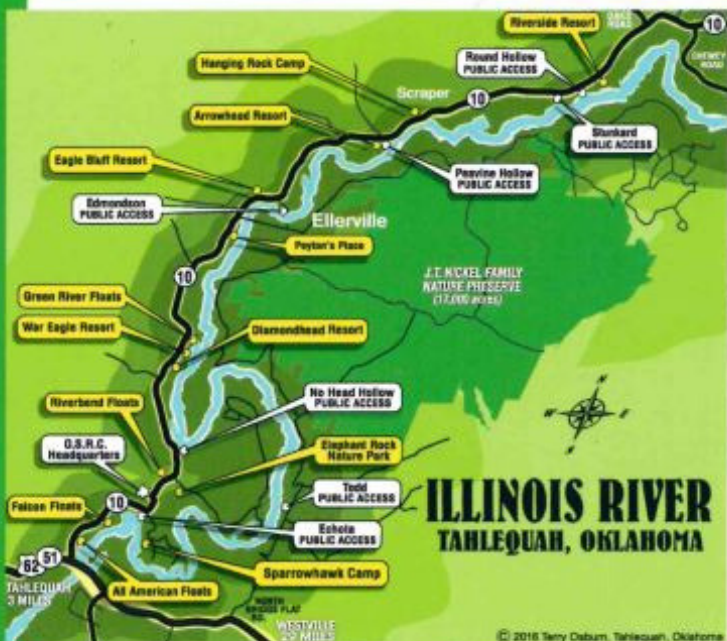


ILLINOIS RIVER

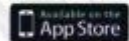
